Content Covered This Week

Math

Unit 2: Decimals- 2.1, 2.2, 2.3

We are discussing how fractions and decimals are similar, and we are discussing place value to the thousandths. The students do a whole group lesson with student leaders, and then get group practice with workbook pages. The students have an opportunity to work in groups given an activity to card which they then solve with their partner, and then write in their math journal using mathtalk according to their math prompt. Continue to work on math facts!

Social Studies: Revolutionary War
